



Schaumburg Youth Citizen Police Academy

The Schaumburg Police Department is hosting a Youth Citizen Police Academy this June.

We are currently accepting applications for the Youth Citizen Police Academy, June 19th – 23rd, 2017 during the hours of 2:30pm-7:00pm (dinner will be provided). The five day academy is FREE to student's ages 13-17 years old who live or go to school in the Village of Schaumburg.

The program provides an opportunity for students to learn about law enforcement and develop a partnership with the police department. Through this one week academy, students will acquire knowledge through both classroom instruction and an interactive curriculum surrounding the law enforcement profession. The Academy is not a boot camp or a program for rebellious teens or youth who have behavioral issues.

All students will receive a certificate of completion, CPR certification, 2-hour credit for volunteer activity. In addition, a Youth Citizen Police Academy t-shirt will be provided. On Friday from 5:30pm-6:30pm, parents are invited to the Police Department for a graduation ceremony where students will be presented their Academy Certificate, followed by cake and coffee.
