

Schaumburg Police – Youth Citizen’s Police Academy – Community Service Project

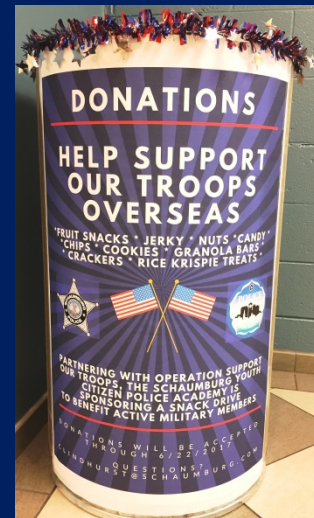
